Scroll to the Mass you want to attend. Click on the **VIEW DETAILS** button (on right).

In the box under QTY (quantity) click the down arrow then select the total number of your family attending.

Click **REGISTER NOW** button

Fill out your details then click on **PROCEED TO FINALIZE REGISTRATION**

Wait for the Congratulations message then exit.
