Ruakaka: Pass Masses and Liturgies

How to get My Vaccine Pass

If you have been double vaccinated and have not yet got your pass you can follow the steps below.

- Through the Health website Log in to mycovidrecord.health.nz and follow the instructions. You will need a unique email address and a valid ID.
- Contact your Chemist
- Phone Ministry of Health 0800222478

Remember to bring your Vaccine Pass with you each time you come to Mass

For the safety of all we ask you to continue wearing your Masks and keeping 1 metre distancing.
