

Lent is traditionally the time to fast, pray and give to those in need.

This Lent we have two ready-made opportunities to do this which are initiatives of our Parish Pastoral Council.

The Market Day for Ukraine being held on the 25th of March in our Parish Hall is an opportunity to fundraise for the people of Ukraine. Preparations are well underway for this but there are still opportunities to help out with your talents or goods or money.
