Next Week's Readings: (Third Sunday of Lent) Exodus 17:3-7: Romans 5:1-2.5-8: John 4:5-42.

Living in the Present Moment

One of the themes in today's readings is about change...of transforming transfiguring one's self.

Did you ever notice that after people reach a milestone wedding anniversary sometimes they put a notice in the local paper accompanied by a picture of the couple. Quite often they look similar to another. It might be the twinkle in their eyes, maybe it's their smile. Love does this. Love makes you like the person you love. You still retain the basics of the personality that you were born with but some aspects of who you are change. If we really love Jesus, we should begin to resemble Him by virtue of our actions.

If we want to be transformed or transfigured so that we are more Christ-like in our lives, we can start by uniting with Him even in the mundane things that make up a lot of our lives...the everyday "stuff."

Perhaps we need to revisit this idea of 'holiness.' It needs to be a holiness based on "living in the present moment." We can't change the past and the future isn't here yet. The present moment is all we can concentrate on.

Are we the same person that we were 5-10-20 years ago? Probably not. Can you point to a moment when your personality dramatically changed in an instant? Probably not. And that's the point.....that's the nature of living in the present moment. Our transfiguration will most likely be a slow and subtle transformation.


