Kaupapa for the Ready the Way: Whakareritia te Ara

- 1. It is primarily a Conversion based process not content based.
- 2. Every Sunday we gather at 10am Mass to listen to the gospel proclaimed.
- 3. The session that is held after Mass is based around the gospel or reading from the Sunday readings. Teachings flow from that.
- 4. It is very important to be present to hear the gospel proclaimed and to link with the faith community of Saint Francis Xavier.
- 5. Parents, family members and supporters, you are a very important part of the process of teaching and preparing your child. You will be with them at every step of the way.
- 6. The process takes as long as it needs to. Your child will receive the Sacraments when they are ready and when we see that there is conversion happening in them.
- 7. Some will receive the Sacraments on the set dates for this programme, some next year, or at another suitable time of the year which we agree upon.
- 8. Parents, please be involved in the faith life of your child outside the classes, help them with questions, prayers, and understanding.

You will be a model to them.

- You and your child are required to attend every lesson and complete both the Reconciliation and Belonging books over the course of the programme. Please bring these to every session.
- Please make sure your child has chosen a Saint they relate to and a sponsor who is over 18 and is a practicing Catholic.
