Next Week's Readings: (The Most Holy BODY and BLOOD of CHRIST) Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16; 1 Corinthians 10:16-17; John 6:51-58.

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen. – a very short sentence that reveals the huge mystery of God. Three distinct persons, one God. Not three Gods, one God three separate persons. Beyond our nature – super-natural.

Together, they illustrate a unity, a oneness bound by love. Separately, they carry out different missions.
