Next Week's Readings: (First Sunday of Advent)

Isaiah 63: 16-17, 64:1, 3-8; 1 Corinthians 1:3-9; Mark 13: 33-37

Christ the King in our lives

Today we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. It's a relatively new feast day in the church's calendar. It was established in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. It's interesting to note that in the biblical writings Jesus never referred to himself as "king". However, quite often Jesus preached about the 'kingdom of God' and how it was emerging into our world through his life and anyone who would follow him. In today's gospel reading, he once again talks about 'my kingdom' but he explicitly distances himself from the title itself.

In Corinthians, Paul asked the question: "If Jesus is alive among us by his resurrection, then how does he affect our lives?" Jesus gives us a road map or a compass to help answer this question. He reminds us to get ready to answer 'yes' to his six questions he asks in today's gospel based on our corporal and spiritual acts of charity. "I was hungry, thirsty, naked, homeless, sick imprisoned; did you help me?" In order to answer 'yes' to these six questions, it's important to keep Jesus front and centre in our lives. We have no problem recognizing Christ in church, but, when we meet him out on the streets where he sometimes appears as hungry, sick, or in need.....are we reluctant even to bid him the time of day?

As we prepare to enter Advent, the Feast of Christ the King calls us to examine our lives, to take a spiritual audit and become focused on what's important so that we can more fully celebrate the great feast of Christmas that is to come.


