Advent ure / Advent urous

The English word 'adventure' comes from the Latin word 'adventurus' meaning "something about to happen". It first appeared in the English language in the 1200s.

Today, we begin the season of Advent. Something is about to happen. From the Catholic point of view, there are three things that are about to happen.

Firstly, there is the adventure of the beginning of the Liturgical New Year for the Church. We look forward to all that will happen in the coming year, some of it we know, some of it we don't know. Secondly, there is the adventure of preparing to celebrate the First Coming of Jesus at that First Christmas.

We are invited into a deeper and more intimate understanding of this event. Thirdly, there is the adventure of looking ahead and preparing for the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of time.


We are invited to set out on these three adventures. The first two we may have been a part of many times before. The third is still to come, wrapped in mystery, unknown, something that will happen in God's good time.


