Dear Parishioners

Blessings of peace to you all.

Today is the celebration of the **Ascension of the Lord**. Next week we celebrate the Gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

In the Gospel of Matthew today we have the wonderful consoling reminder from Jesus "and know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time". We depend on the presence, help and guidance of Jesus.

In the First reading from the Acts of the Apostles Jesus commissions them and us to be his witnesses "indeed to the ends of the world. I can't help but think – in relation to Israel – Aotearoa NZ is the end of the World!

We don't go around looking into the clouds- we are called to look outwards towards others on the mission of Jesus.

I am at a loss to understand why so many things are opening and we cannot gather for Church.

However, we have made a start; St Francis Xavier Church is **open** on Thursdays to Saturdays for **Prayer and Reconciliation** 11:30 am to 1:30 pm.

We are in hopeful anticipation for celebrating Masses and Liturgies next weekend. Again, we await the Government announcement on Monday. Our bishops have made a strong plea to be able to gather in groups of at least 100.

Even at that number we cannot expect to accommodate all in regular Masses

Hence: We plan to add an **extra Mass at 12:00 noon on Sundays at St Francis Xavier.**We are planning on providing if necessary, a liturgy of the Word and Holy Communion for the overflow from the scheduled Masses.

2 – In order to gather we have to fulfil **Safety Regulations** In each place we need specific people organised for:

Reception: Checking and noting **Contact tracing information**Ushering: Allocating **safe Distance Seating**

Sanitizing of surfaces after Mass.

We also require **coordinators** for these roles.
